USC BEAUFORT PALMETTO COLLEGE PROGRAM SPECIFICS

In addition to the required courses listed on the previous page, specific requirements must be met for the USC Beaufort Palmetto College Degree Completion Program. Also, certain technological requirements are necessary to be successful in the program.

UNIVERSITY REQUIREMENTS

Institutional requirements for Palmetto College Sociology are for students to complete 50% of their major courses, as well as 30 of the last 46 credit hours, in residency at USCB. This means they must be completed through USC Beaufort directly and not transferred in from a different institution or USC System School. Students must also reach a minimum of 120 credit hours overall, so additional elective hours may be required.

Two requirements within the General Education curriculum are ideally met with another required course. However, if you have transferred courses into all the areas where these requirements can be met, you will need additional courses to satisfy them.

- **Global Citizenship and Multicultural Understanding Studies:** The General Education goal for students to recognize and value diversity and understand global and cultural perspectives can be met through ANTH B102, ANTH B312, ANTH B317, ANTH B351, ANTH B352, ANTH B452, COMM B450, EDCI B322, ENGL B270, ENGL B291, ENGL B441, GEOG B121, GLST B301, GLST B398, HIST B109, HIST B115, HIST B116, HRTM B360, NURS B330, PUBH B300, PSYC B380, RELG B203, SOCY B315 and SPAN B380.
- **REACH Act:** South Carolina Act 26 of 2021 requires undergraduate students to complete a 3-credit course that requires, at a minimum, the reading of the U.S. Constitution, the Declaration of Independence, the Emancipation Proclamation, five Federalist Papers, and one document foundational to the African-American Struggle. These documents are known as the "Founding Documents, and the requirement can be met through HIST B101, HIST B111, HIST B115, POLI B201, & UNIV B101
